Dr. June Kan-Mitchell was born in Hong Kong. She obtained her B.A. cum laude in Biochemistry from Smith College (MA) and her doctorate from Yale University. She has been Associate Professor at University of Southern California, Associate Adjunct Professor at University of California San Diego, and Professor with tenure at Wayne State University. She is currently Professor in Biological Sciences at The University of Texas (El Paso).

Her interest is focused on HIV vaccines. Dr. Kan-Mitchell will discuss her experience with antigen-specific CD8+ T cells generated in vitro from healthy seronegative donors and from patients, to provide insights into human immune responses that may be relevant to successful vaccination.
