The Barcelona Biomedical Research Park (PRBB)

The PRBB is a large scientific infrastructure employing 1,400 people. It hosts seven independent research centres and is physically connected to the Hospital del Mar. The building occupies 55,000 m² and was opened in 2006.

The PRBB Consortium coordinates and manages the common services such as the animal facility, cafeteria, maintenance, cleaning, security, and reception.

In addition, the PRBB Communication and PR Department collaborates with the communication departments of all the centres to ensure the park's internal communications and outreach.

Bulletin boards:

Schedules



The building is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
